

F-SUTA Office and State Council Elections – 2012



The following F-SUTA leadership and State Council positions are open for nomination:

Recording Secretary	2-Year Term
Corresponding Secretary	2-Year Term
Treasurer	2-Year Term
Executive Board Member-At-Large (4 Seats)	2-Year Term
Executive Board Member-At-Large (1 Seat)	1-Year Term
State Council Representative	3-Year Term

Elections will be held April 30-May 11, 2012

- Nominations may be made on the floor at the Representative Council meetings held on March 19 and April 23, OR may be sent through District Mail to F-SUTA, or faxed to 864-6284.
- Declaration of Candidacy forms, including a 50 word (or less) Candidate Statement, must be submitted before a candidate may be nominated. (State Council must be 25 words or less.) Mail to the SEC office at 4735 Central Way, Fairfield, 94534, or fax to 864-6284. The Declaration of Candidacy form must be received in the SEC office by 4 p.m. on April 23, 2012.
- Ballots and Rosters will be prepared by the Election Committee and distributed to all sites prior to April 30, 2012. Site Representatives have the responsibility for running site elections and returning all ballots and election materials by Monday, May 14, 2012 no later than 5 p.m. at the SEC office, 4735 Central Way, Suite C.
- The Elections Committee will count ballots the week of May 14th and the results of the election will be announced no later than May 17, 2012. Elections results will be posted at fsuta.org immediately and sent to Site Reps. via email to post at sites.
- F-SUTA Leadership and State Council Representatives must be elected by a majority vote (a number greater than half of the total legal ballots cast). Alternate State Council Representatives shall be elected by a plurality vote (a number greater than another).
- Run-off elections will take place May 21-June 2 in the event a candidate does not receive a majority vote.
- Challenges must be in writing, using the official CTA Challenge Form within ten (10) calendar days after the announcement of election results. Challenging party(ies) must notify the unit president and elections chair of the challenge.
